Some of our benefits & services

- **Baby Bonus** – a Sweet Lullabies gift voucher ...for any member with a new addition to their family.
- **First-Aid Refund** – the Society will refund the course fees ...for any or all members of the family.
- **HomeHelp** – Housekeeping, Lawnmowing, Firewood, etc. to help when you or your partner are incapacitated.
- **Personal Care & Counselling** – qualified personal assistance with mental health, grief, relationship issues.
- **Convalescent Benefit** – a Gift Card or cash, a weekend away — to help you recover after a prolonged injury or illness. (also available for your partner)
- **Welfare Fund** – the Board will consider all claims for assistance, and discretionary funds will be made available to assist families in a variety of circumstances, particularly those with children with special needs.
- **Mortuary Benefit** – the Society pays a substantial contribution towards the funeral costs for any Member, their partner or their dependent children.
- **Travel & Accommodation** – a travel allowance if someone in your family needs to travel to a Metropolitan Hospital and reimbursement of accommodation costs.

The Society is governed by a Board of Directors made up of employees like you and administered by dedicated employees in their spare time – we are very proud of our achievements and our ability to support those members and their families who may need of some help or practical assistance.

Typically, around 20% of members receive some form of assistance from the Society each year — they are supported by the rest, like one big family helping out those in need.

Of course, it's not all gloomy stuff – there's the Baby Bonus to help you celebrate a new arrival in the family. We also refund course fees for First Aid training for anyone or everyone in your family.
